Topic: How does Canadian Politics and Government Impact an Individual's Ability to Access Justice?

In connection with the 2023 Youth Leaders in Law Conferences across Canada, Calgary Family Law Associates (CFLA) is sponsoring a competition for high school students to submit a piece of personal work on the topic of:

How does Canadian politics and government impact an individual's ability to access justice?

In recent years, the Department of Justice has pledged to “advance a people-centered approach to justice”. In fact, they have committed to promote access to justice through the UN’s 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The Department of Justice is particularly committed to SDG 16, which commits the government to “**promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all, and build effective, accountable, and inclusive institutions at all levels.**”

In Canada, all levels of government - municipal, provincial, and federal - have a responsibility to ensure no one is left behind. The common theme behind political discourse relates to *how* we achieve this.

Competition entries can focus on the broad implications of politics and government on access to justice and/or specific political issues that pertain to access to justice.

Monetary prizes will be awarded for the top 3 entries as follows:

1st prize - \$300,

2nd prize - \$150, and

3rd prize - \$50.

Submissions may be made by any high school student in Canada in their choice of media: essay, poem, story, script, art, video. Written entries must be 5 pages or less. Video entries must be 5 minutes or less.

Submissions will be judged anonymously by CFLA lawyers. Winning entries may be posted online.
